What is the RDA?

- ▶ RDA stands for Research Data Alliance, it is an international organisation that brings together data experts from all over the world.

1. Purpose and scope

- ▶ RDA Europe issued a [call](#) for European organisations to formulate project proposals for the implementation of existing RDA *recommendations & outputs*
- ▶ The [list](#) of *RDA recommendations & outputs* is extensive, but we selected one topic that we consider to have broad support in the Netherlands: [23 Things - Libraries for Research Data](#). The idea is to elaborate on this proposal with regard to how it relates to a Dutch context.
- ▶ For example to broaden its scope to include not only librarians but also other data experts/data stewards (format still to be decided). We aim to submit a project proposal for the RDA call based on this idea.

2. Why is this important?

- ▶ By submitting a project proposal, we aim to link up with RDM products within a European and international framework.
- ▶ The LCRDM and partner organisations/experts can raise their profile by pursuing RDM cooperation at an international level.

3. Expected results?

- ▶ Step 1: complete the form by drawing up a project proposal that will work for the Dutch RDM network.
- ▶ Long-term perspective: take part in the project after it has been approved. Task group members are invited to participate in the project, but depending on the final project proposal it may be possible to draft a new pitch.

4. Task Group

- ▶ We are looking for approximately 6 people from various types of research institutes to assist in drafting a project proposal.
- ▶ Participation of representatives from other Dutch Stakeholders (for example the UKB WG, the LIBER WG, RDNL, NPOS, RDA-NL Working Group, NDE, DTL, Go FAIR NL etc.) would be much appreciated.

5. When must the task be completed?

- ▶ Three weeks (11 February - 4 March 2019)
- ▶ Based on the deadline for submitting the project proposal to this call (4 March 2019) we have adopted the following time frame:

Week 7 (11-15 February): first meeting task group (via skype)

Week 8 (18-22 February): work out project proposal

Week 9 (25 February-1March): finalize project proposal

-> 4 March 2019 -17.00 hrs: final deadline for submitting project proposal
